Grassroots Programs

As Canada's National Junior Golf Development Program, *Future Links driven by Acura* programs guarantee golfers a positive, fun-filled and exciting experience. This program is appropriately segmented into three pillar programs: Facility, In-School and Outreach. In 2018, we witnessed a 22% increase in junior programming, that's over 556,000 kids participating in the *Future Links driven by Acura* programs!

Young Pro Program

Launched in 2014, the Young Pro Program's goal is to put top graduating Canadian amateurs on a performance path that replicates the success of major winners and transitions them to a career in professional golf. It focuses on enhancing coaching and training experiences through the latest in sport science support, and mental training, while providing financial support for golf expenses.
